

Fallen Walls and Open Doors

In 2005, Keith Lancaster released the song "Fallen Walls and Open Doors". I have always liked its message. One of the lines in the song is "The walls are falling and doors keep flying open". The chorus goes on to state:



"Fallen walls and Open Doors We are not bound anymore We must follow any course To open doors and fallen walls."

A year ago, so many doors were shut. Well, since the spring of 2020, really is when prison doors began to slam shut due to the COVID pandemic. At this time last year it seemed like there was no end in sight. But the grating sound of iron hinges turning as prison doors open- well that, too, is music to our ears!

Last month we shared with you that the Stevenson Unit in Cuero had opened its doors to us as Dr. Don Umphrey and I were able to show *The Meanest Man in Texas* movie and preach to approximately 135 prisoners. 58 signed up for follow up Bible Correspondence studies.

We are working with the chaplain to come back for more follow up visits in May and June. Cole Mealer and Mark Spaeth from the Central Church in Victoria have completed their TDCJ volunteer training and are also scheduling weekly teaching



visits using the NewLife Behavior curriculum.

The Coastal Bend Detention Center federal facility at Robstown is opening its gates and our men and women's teams will begin teaching weekly classes this month. Please pray the work of Merced Aguilar, Stella Garcia, Pat and Glenda Watson are blessed!

The CoreCivic Coastal Bend Rehabilitation Center (a TDCJ parole facility in Corpus Christi) has requested we put a team together to teach Saturday evening group and host a Sunday worship service at their facility! Please pray for Rick Cantu and Robert Johnson as we begin holding CASA group studies on Saturday evenings. Please pray for Tony Robison, Jesus Villanueva, and Daniel Pena as we begin Sunday worship services! CASA classes have begun at the Kings Crossing church building on Wednesday evenings. The Garza West unit in Beeville expects our return in June. Please pray!

"Baptistries Around the World" is also active in our backyard!

We are used to putting our portable baptistries together, packing them in a box and shipping them to a missionary on another continent. That is why it is pretty special when we get to use them in our own backyard. In April, Buck Griffith had the privilege of taking one of our portable baptistries to the backyard of an elderly woman who could not travel and baptized her. This month, we are working out logistics with Nueces County jail officials to fulfill baptism requests of eight women and two men. Please continue to pray for this work as every month it produces fruit of souls! If you are able to give to this effort, please do so.



World Bible School Bibles (helped needed to purchase more)

Tuesdays are typical days for our men and women's teams to go to county jails to teach. Frank Maxey, Cheryl Hinton, Otha Barcus, Glenda Watson, Jenifer Hill, Jesus Villanueva, Dr. Don Umphrey, Buck and I fill our bags with WBS Bibles, Bible correspondence sign-up sheets and empty the office to fill up jail meeting rooms. It is normal for us to see 50-60 prisoners in class. Last week I looked at the shelves where we store the WBS Bibles and counted only 20! We loaded up the following Monday and came back with 1,000 Bibles (50 boxes)! With shipping costs these Bibles run about \$5 each and come in a box of 20. We are putting the Bible in prisoners' hands and then teaching them once there. If you can help us financially in purchasing Bibles, please dol
